Apache Subversion 1.7.5 builds on the major improvements and new features introduced in Subversion 1.7, which included the new `svnrdump` remote dumpfile tool and a complete rewrite of the working copy metadata system. Subversion 1.7.5's enhancements and fixes include:

- * a performance improvement for scanning the working copy root
- * a memory and file-handle management improvement
- * a fix for regression from version 1.6 in update with `--depth` option
- * a fix for `svn update --depth=empty` against 1.4 servers

The full list of what's new and noteworthy in Apache Subversion 1.7.5 is available in the Changes file. The latest, certified open source binaries are available from the WANdisco website and also through uberSVN.

As part of its commitment to the Subversion community, WANdisco recently announced the next set of SVN webinars in their free training program, including an Advanced Branching and Merging webinar. WANdisco also offers professional support for Apache Subversion, and migration packages specifically designed for SVN users who are migrating to the latest 1.7 release.
